Whilst the next two weeks will pose a new and interesting challenge to learning (both in school and remotely!) we hope to be able to offer regular opportunities for learning to punctuate your days. The next 1-2 weeks will be a learning curve for us all, please let us know how things are going?

I am writing today to get a feel for whether we need to offer any provision for the Easter break? I will reiterate the Government guidance again that, if at all possible, **children should stay at home wherever feasible**. However, we are aware that there may be unavoidable circumstances that will require us to provide child-care above and beyond our normal hours for Key Worker children.

This will allow us to make effective plans. **The Easter break runs from Monday 6th April to Friday 17th April.**

If I do not hear back from anyone by the end of the day on Wednesday 25th March, I will assume there will be no need to set up additional provision.
