

How we plan to use our Sports Premium Money at Bridstow CE Primary School

From September 2013 each Primary school has received extra sports funding through the Sports Pupil Premium. In our school this will amount to **£8550** for 2016-17. This may increase due to funding from the new 'sugar tax' but is yet to be confirmed. We intend to use the existing allocation to achieve a number of sustainable objectives:

1. To develop the leadership of PE to enable quality provision to become sustainable and high quality.
2. To develop and enhance the teaching of PE across the curriculum in all classes.
3. To offer a wider range of sporting opportunities outside of school hours that caters for a wider variety of the pupil population.
4. To further develop and enhance the opportunities for inter-school competition and competitive sport.

BUDGET - £8550

- **£3500** Specialist Coaching to support teacher's delivering high quality PE-Games
- **£3500** Specialist Coaching to support teacher's delivering high quality PE-Swimming
- **£150** Attendance at training events support teacher's delivering high quality PE. In particular a focus on swimming, dance and gymnastics.
- **£350** Membership of local sports cluster organising opportunities for inter-school competition.
- **£500** Increasing the provision of extra curriculum clubs (Golf, Football and Dance)
- **£500** New Playtime and Lunchtime sports provision

TOTAL: £8500

We plan to carry over any remaining budget (or additional funding) in order to develop a playground fitness project in 2017-18 with the Sports Premium allocated.

HOW THE IMPACT WILL BE MEASURED:-

1. Staff will have a greater confidence in planning and delivering high quality PE. This will come from observations of pupils and staff during PE lessons and teachers using their improved knowledge to run their own clubs.
2. Equipment will be used more effectively. This will come from observations of lessons.
3. Pupil Voice - Feedback from pupils will feature as part of the impact measured.
4. An increase in participation in after school clubs and sports in general. This will come from club registers and feedback from specialist coaches and teachers.
