Wildlife and pond dipping area

We are excited to announce that as a result of a successful bid for £3000 from the Herefordshire Council Catch up Grant Fund we now have a fantastic new pond dipping area complete with purpose platforms built and a surfaced path around the pond area. Although the 'wildlife area' at the back of the school has been used for outdoor learning in the past, overgrowth and lack of funding for upkeep has meant that it has become



unusable in recent years. The work on the site was undertaken by Kevin of Wye Landscapes of Ruardean and involved extensive tree, scrub and foliage clearance as well as construction of the bridge and pond dipping platforms and construction of paths. We are so pleased with the results and cannot wait to get the children out there for outdoor learning, science etc.

Sports Day

A reminder that Sports Day is taking place on the afternoon of **Monday 18**th **July from 1.15pm** until the end of the day. Parents and carers are invited to watch proceedings in the outdoor seating areas provided.

The PTFA have kindly offered to provide refreshments (for adults only).


After School Clubs
