

Covid-19 Update

Following updated Government Guidance made public at the start of April, the school will follow the following procedures for Covid-19 cases and symptomatic children:

• Children who are unwell and have a high temperature should stay at home and avoid contact with other people. They can return to school when they no longer have a high temperature, and they are well enough to attend.







• Children with a positive Covid-19 test result should stay home and avoid contact with people for 3 days.

Please ensure you phone the school (either leave a message on the absence line or speak directly) if there is a positive case for a child in the school. This will enable us to manage the risk best.

iPad Scheme

Thank you to the 42 families that responded to the iPad community scheme survey. We had 27/42 families interested in taking part on the scheme. We are now in the process of putting together more detailed information and further answers to queries that were raised to ensure everyone will be fully informed. We hope to instigate the programme before the end of the academic – based upon availability of devices.
